Rose Point ECS 2011: Where Did the Commands Go?

Introduction

This document lists all of the commands from Rose Point ECS 2009 and describes where to find them (or their equivalents) in Rose Point ECS 2011.

Menu Bar Commands

File > New, File > Open, File > Save, and File > Save As: these are all on the Main Menu.

File > Page Setup, File > Print Preview, and File > Print: these are all on the Main Menu under Print.

File > Send To: This are not available yet, but will appear on the Main Menu at some point.

File > Export and File > Import: these are on the Marks toolbar.

File > Recently used files: these are on the Main Menu under Recent

File > Exit: this is on the Main Menu.

Edit > Undo and Edit > Redo: These are on the Home and Marks toolbars.

Edit > Cut, Edit > Copy, Edit > Paste, and Edit > Delete: These are on appropriate context menus (right-click menus) and toolbars (and Ctrl+X, Ctrl+C, Ctrl+V, and Del).

Edit > Select All: Use Ctrl+A

Edit > Find: this is the Find Box on the tab bar (Ctrl+F will activate the Find Box).

View > Quilting: this is on the Chart Tools menu on each chart viewer.

View > Scale: these commands for selecting specific scales are no longer available.

View > Orientation: this is a button on the chart view controls as well as the U key.

View > Task Pane: the Task Pane can be turned on and off by clicking on the Task Pane tabs.

View > Status Bar: the status bar can no longer be disabled and is a permanent part of the tab bar.

View > Chart Outlines: this is on the Chart Tools menu on each chart viewer under Extra Layers

View > Distance Scale: this is on the Chart Tools menu on each chart viewer under Extra Layers

View > Browser Panel: the browsers are selected using the tab bar now.

View > Full Screen: this is on the Screen Control menu on the Home toolbar.

View > Properties: this is on appropriate context menus as well as the Properties Task Bar tab.

Insert > object: these commands are on the Home toolbar

Insert > Navigation Object File: use Import on the Marks browser toolbar.

Format > Base Object Display, Format > Standard Object Display, Format > Full Object Display: moved to the Chart Tools > Vector Charts menu.

Format > Vector Charts: moved to Chart Tools > Vector Charts > More Options.

Format > Text Size: this is on the Chart Tools menu on each chart viewer.

Format > Chart Types and Format > Chart Colors: moved to Chart Tools

Format > Tide Levels and Format > Tidal Currents: moved to Chart Tools > Extra Layers.

Format > Raster Chart Note Links: moved to Chart Tools > Raster Charts.

Tools > Chart Portfolio: moved to Main Menu > Charts.

Tools > Download/Install Charts: the download features are now part of the Sync button and the installation features have been moved to Main Menu > Charts > Install Charts.

Tools > Navigation Object Browser: use the Ship's Log browser for Events and Tracks, and use the Marks browser for other navigation object types.

Tools > Weather: use the Conditions browser.

Tools > Activate Route and **Tools > Deactivate Route**: use the route context menu, or the Voyage Plan browser toolbar.

Tools > Enable Tracking and **Tools > Start New Track**: right-click on the boat.

Tools > Ship's Log and Tools > New Ship's Log Entry: Use the Ship's Log browser.

Tools > Planning Mode and **Tools > Cruise Mode**: these are on the Screen Control menu on the Home toolbar.

Tools > Configure Vessel and Electronics and Tools > Options: moved to the main menu.

Help > Contents and Index and Help > Keyboard Shortcuts: moved to the main menu under Help > Documentation.

Help > Welcome Window: integrated into Main Menu > Help > Getting Started.

Help > Coastal Explorer Network, Help > Send Feedback, and Help > Product Support: moved to Main Menu > Help > Support.

Help > License Activation: moved to Main Menu > Help > License Registration.

Help > Check for Updates: part of the Sync feature now.

Help > About: moved to Main Menu > Help > About.

Toolbar Commands

Back and Forward: These are on the tab bar.

Find Box: This was moved to the right side of the window.

Chart Scale Controls: These were moved to each chart viewer.

Select, Zoom, and Pan Tools: these are not currently available.

One Chart View and **Two Chart Views**: these are on the Screen Control menu on the Home toolbar.

Undo and **Redo**: these are on the Home and Marks toolbars (as well as Ctrl+X and Ctrl +Y).

Highlight Objects: this is on the Chart Tools menu on each chart viewer under Chart Colors.

Add Route, Add Mark, Add Boundary Circle, Add Boundary Area, and Add RBL: these are on the Home and Marks toolbars.

Go To Boat: this is a button on each chart viewer now.

Browser Panel: these are now the tabs across the top of the window.

NOTE: "Chart Tools" refers to the button on each chart panel that shows a wrench.
